Eligibility

All competitors must be enrolled at the school on the day of competition, are under the age of 19 years as at 1 January 2010 and satisfy the eligibility criteria for secondary school sporting competitions as set by NZSSSC.

Competitors must also be a member of the New Zealand blokart Association, either by joining their local club, or directly with the New Zealand blokart Association. The current association membership is included in the club subscription, or for competitors joining the association directly, the cost is \$10 for an individual or \$50 for a family membership.



Entries and Registration

The entry forms enclosed will also be available from the NZ blokart Association at www.bai.co.nz.

Please take care in completing the forms. Ensure names can be easily interpreted and pay special attention to ensuring all information is provided.

Entries are not considered complete and will not be processed until the following is met:

Full entry fee must accompany entry form.

All competitors are members of the NZBAI either directly or through their local club

All required forms sent to NZBAI by Closing Date.

Registrations close on Wednesday 27 October 2010.

Entry Fees

The entry fee is \$30 per competitor.

There is an additional \$15 late entry fee.

Late Entries

Entries received after the Closing Date for Entries on the Wednesday 27 October 2010, will be accepted at the organisers discretion. An additional late fee of \$15 per competitor will be charged.



Entry Fee Refund Policy

NO ENTRY FEE, OR ANY PORTION OF SUCH FEE, will be refunded to a competitor or team that withdraws from this event after the Entry Closing date of Wednesday 27 October 2010.

Club membership fees and NZBAI membership fees are not refundable.

Insurance, Safety, Liability and Indemnity

All competitors are required to belong to the NZBAI as the NZBAI membership fee contributes towards the NZBAI public liability insurance that covers the event.

Competitors are liable for damage to their own karts, whether caused by their actions or others, and wear and tear.

Tournament Format

The Race Director has the discretion to determine the number of races and courses in accordance with weather conditions and time available.

Weight Divisions

Students will compete as individuals in one of two divisions: Under 60kg or Over 60kg.

Blokart Identification

Competitors must have a transponder attached to their kart. If you do not own a transponder one can be hired at a cost of \$5.00 per day. You need to indicate on the entry form if you need to hire a transponder.

Shared Use of Blokarts

Two students may share a blokart as long as they are in different weight divisions. Each competitor will have their own transponder that will have to be swapped between races.

Rules

All competitors must abide by the International blokart Racing Association Rules as adapted by the Auckland Blokart Club for the event. These rules can be download at www.bai.co.nz.

Blokarts can race as production or performance.

A Notice of Race is available from the Auckland Blokart Club

Venue specific rules will be notified at the pilot's briefing before racing commences each day. Competitors must wear the appropriate safety equipment as specified in the rules.

Pilots Briefing

All competitors must attend the Pilot's Briefing that proceeds each day of racing and when called for during the event for course changes or additional instructions.

Additional Requirements

Competitors are required to assist in helping the event run smoothly, as directed by the organisers.

Awards Presentation

The Awards Ceremony will be held on Sunday 31 October at the conclusion of the event. The Awards Ceremony will include presentation of trophies.
